

MAXIMIZING NEONATAL SURVIVAL

The health seminar lecture for the 2008 GPCA National will be **MAXIMIZING NEONATAL SURVIVAL**. It will be presented by Dr. Robert Hutchinson on May 1st at 7:30p.m. It will cover whelping, dystocia, and the puppy neonate. This is a new lecture for most of us so it should be well worth attending with your notebooks.

Dr. Hutchison received his DVM in 1972 from The Ohio State of Veterinary Medicine. He is currently director of Animal Clinic Northview Inc, a 10 doctor practice located in North Ridgeville, Ohio.

Dr Hutchison is internationally recognized for work with canine frozen semen and canine reproduction. He is an off-quarter advisor at six veterinary colleges including OSU, Virginia Tech, Perdue, Tufts, and Michigan State University, for students interested in small animal theriogenology.

He has authored numerous articles on canine reproduction and various breed journals and magazines, has appeared on television, and lectured internationally on reproduction, whelping, pediatric, and canine/feline infertility.

Our Speaker is the director of the International Canine Semen Bank - Ohio, a canine frozen semen center which he started in 1984. He has also produced a DVD on canine reproduction that is available at the Northview Clinic. .
