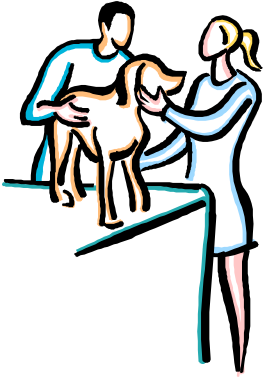


Patella Screening at the 2008 GPCA National Specialty



Heart of Ohio Great Pyrenees Club will sponsor a Patella Screening Clinic on Friday May 2nd, 2008, starting at 1:00 p.m. This is your chance to have your dog's patella screening for OFA certification completed while you enjoy the National Specialty.

Members of the GPCA Health Committee will staff this event and be on hand to answer any questions you may have. The exam will be performed in complete privacy by Dr. Becca Pentecost of the Animal Clinic North View

All necessary paperwork will be completed at that time and sent in to OFA. **As this is a special event, OFA has reduced the certification fee by 50% ! What a great opportunity to take advantage of the convenience and 50% savings in getting one step closer to receiving a CHIC number!**

The fee is as follows:

Patella exam: \$20.00

OFA fee: \$ 7.50

A permanent ID is necessary for this certification. If your dog does not meet this requirement, Dr. Pentecost will provide micro chipping at the time of the exam.

(Micro chipping is available only for dogs registered at the patella clinic)

The paperwork for the AVID chip registration will be done at the same time.

Micro chipping fee: \$20.00

(All proceeds will go to HOGPC Rescue ,Inc.)

The patella clinic will be by appointment only. Please make your reservations on the Specialty Sign-up sheet in the Premium list.

Please include your check for \$47.50 to cover the exam, OFA fee and micro chipping.

Exam and OFA fee (only) is \$27.50

As pre-registration is required, you will be given a scheduled time before the exam day.
